He's also been a NASA Solar System Ambassador since 2009 and serves as the "Astrobiology Ambassador" for the NASA/MIRS/UNCF Special Program Corporation's Astrobiology Partnership Program. One of his newest honors is an appointment to the outreach advisory board for the world's largest telescope, the new Thirty-Meter-Telescope at Mauna Kea in Hawaii. He appears regularly in the media as a science content expert including appearances on the "Colbert Report" on Comedy Central and "The Late, Late Show with Craig

Ferguson" on CBS. For more than two decades, Derrick has hosted awardwinning astronomy radio programs for Philadelphia's two public radio stations and created signature astronomy television programming for PBS. One of the highlights of Derrick's was career meeting President Obama and his family when he was invited to participate in the first-ever White House Star Party.
